The American Academy of Arts and Letters Announces Winners of Awards in Art

Robin Scher reports in *Artnews* that the American Academy of Arts and Letters have announced the nine artists who will each receive a \$10,000 prize at the Academy's annual awards in New York this May. The winners were chosen from a pool of thirty-seven artists who participated in the Academy's Invitational Exhibition of Visual Art, which remains open through April 10. Guy Goodwin, Anthony McCall, Nancy Mitchnick, Joan Snyder, and Lee Tribe are the winners of the Arts and Letters Awards in Art, which honor "exceptional accomplishments," while Carmen Cicero and Patricia Patterson are the winners of the Jacob Lawrence and Gwendolyn Knight Lawrence Awards. The William L. Metcalf Award, which is given to a "young artist of great promise," has been awarded to Aleah Chapin, and the Rosenthal Family Foundation Award in Painting will go to Chuck Webster.
